SCHOOL RULES & EXPECTATIONS

General Behaviour

- All students must show respect and consideration to all members of the school community, visitors and to the school environment.
- Students must take responsibility for their own learning and behaviour with the support of school staff.

Classroom Behaviour

- Students are expected to do their best, catch up on work they have missed while absent and have everything they need for class.
- Students are expected to show respect for rules and routines of the classroom.

Attendance

- Students must have an approved reason for missing school. Parents must call the school if their child is absent.
- Holidays must not be taken during school time.
- Please try to avoid appointments during school hours.
- Please use the Quad to enter the school. If late use entrance by main office.

Punctuality

• Students are expected to be on time for school and class.

Notes

- If a student is absent, late for school or leaving early parents must fill out the required form at the back of the school journal.
- Students must follow the correct procedures when signing in/out of school.

Uniform

- Full uniform must be worn at all times.
- Piercings should be removed before coming to school and if this is not possible, they must be covered at all times.

Forbidden Substances

- Forbidden substances include: Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, Chewing Gum and Tippex
- These substances are not allowed on school premises or on any school outings.

Lunchtime and Breaks

- Students cannot leave the school grounds without permission.
- Students must eat in their designated area which must be kept clean and tidy.

PROPERTY

Mobile Phone

- The use of a mobile phone and similar devices (e.g. iPod) is not allowed outside of lunchtime and morning break. These devices should be turned off during class.
- If a student is caught using such a device, their parents must collect phone from the office at the end of the school day and pay €20.

Lockers

- Lockers are school property, which should be kept tidy and locked and may be inspected.
- Lockers cannot be used between classes without permission.


Student Journal


 The student journal must be kept in good condition and must be with the student at all times.


